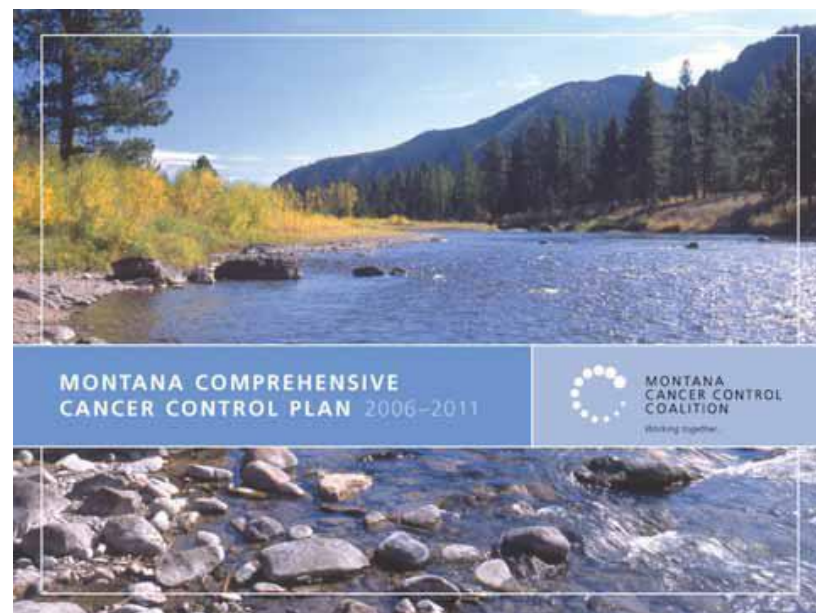

Who we are...

The MTCCC (Montana Cancer Control Coalition) is a coalition made up of individuals and concerned citizens in addition to representatives from diverse organizations working together to reduce the overall burden of cancer for Montanans. We have published a 5 year plan to help us through this process and are actively working to reach our goals.

The MTCCC strives to ensure better quality of life for those diagnosed with cancer and works to enhance the odds of survivorship through prevention, early detection and state-of-the-art cancer care.

Our Mission...

The Montana CCC Plan (2006-2011) is a guide for achieving the following overarching goals:

- To reduce cancer incidence, morbidity, and mortality in Montana through a collaborative partnership of private and public individuals and organizations.
- To develop, implement, promote, and advocate for a statewide, coordinated, integrated approach to control cancer for all Montanans.
- To ensure quality of life through prevention, early detection, treatment, research, rehabilitation, and palliation.

A comprehensive, statewide, evidence-based approach to reduce the burden of cancer in Montana, motivated by compassion...an investment in the future.

Any individual or organization interested in cancer control activities are invited to participate in the MTCCC. Our members participate in Implementation Groups focus on reaching specific goals and objectives within the MT CCC Plan.
