Implementation of Survivorship Care Plans:

Physical Component within Survivorship Care Plans:

- Describe the prevalence of pain in the cancer patient population; and
- Identify specific causes of pain in cancer patients.

Emotional Component within Survivorship Care Plans:

- Identify common feelings cancer survivors share post treatment; and
- Recognize when a cancer survivor should seek support post treatment.

Practical Component within Survivorship Care Plans:

- Describe the importance for communication between the cancer survivor, physician, and oncologist during transition of care; and
- Recognize teamwork barriers and how to remedy them.

Additional Survivorship Care Plan Objectives:

- Recognize the importance of a survivorship care plan from a survivor perspective;
- Discuss evidence based complementary medicine modalities and their role in cancer; as well as
- Provide adequate time for questions and answers about Survivorship Care Plans in Montana.
